HEALTH & SAFETY

- 1. The Out of School Club will be registered and inspected by Ofsted under the Children Act 1989.
- 2. A health and safety checklist will be completed at the beginning of each session.
- 3. During term times a fire drill will be undertaken once a month on different days and times within the session, during Holiday club these will be performed at the start of the holiday club.
- 4. A visual health and safety inspection will be undertaken daily.
- 5. Staff must attend any appropriate training on health and safety as identified by the manager.
- 6. All staff must be familiar with Health and Safety requirements and deal pro-actively with any health and safety risks.
- 7. Activities within the club should always have a level of staff supervision which is appropriate to the task I hand
- 8. All accidents must be recorded in the accident folder on the correct forms.
- 9. Parents/ carers should be informed of any accident involving their child and be asked to sign the accident sheet.
- 10. The club will maintain a first aid box, medication, and allergy folder.
- 11. The club registration forms will ask for any medical information pertaining to the individual child.
- 12. In the event of a child requiring urgent medical attention, the club manager will make every effort to contact the parent/carer immediately. However in the event of a child's health being a risk, the club reserves the right to seek urgent medical assistance based upon the advice of a doctor, where a parent cannot be reached the named adult will be contacted.
- 13. All staff will spend time reading and familiarising themselves with the Health and Safety policy during their induction.
